

## **Expectations of an Instructor**

For those involved in instructing trainee divers regardless of whether new divers or those progressing their skills, the following detail some of the expectations placed upon you as an instructor.

- Operate within the rules and safety codes of The British Sub-Aqua Club
- Encourage all sections of society to participate in our sport in line with national guidelines.
- Respect the rights and dignity of the trainee.
- Be aware of BSAC's Safeguarding Policy and understand the actions to take if a concern is identified
- Ensure any physical contact with a trainee is appropriate to the requirements of snorkelling or diving
- Refer any concerns raised by a trainee to the relevant club officer
- Never instruct above your level of training and qualification
- Maintain a current Enhanced DBS check or complete a Self-Disclosure form as required for your position
- Ensure equipment provided is suitable for purpose
- Never ridicule or shout at a trainee for making a mistake
- Be courteous to trainees and other club members
- Be reasonable in your requests to, and expectations of a trainee
- In the event of sudden illness or accident seek appropriate support in accordance with where you are instructing
