

Standards of Behaviour for Club Members

General

- ✓ Treat all club members and persons associated with our sport with dignity and respect
- ✓ Treat everyone equally and do not discriminate against another person associated with our sport on any grounds including gender, disability, culture, background, age, religion, ethnic origin or sexual orientation
- ✓ Do not use inappropriate, abusive or offensive language
- ✓ Do not tolerate bullying, harassment or physical violence of yourself or anyone else in our club – report it to the Club Welfare Officer, action could be taken through the club disciplinary or the child welfare policies
- ✓ Recognise and celebrate your own success and the success of other club members

In Training

- ✓ Treat your instructor and other trainees with respect
- ✓ Listen to what your instructor tells you and follow the instructions given
- ✓ If in doubt, ask for clarification
- ✓ Let your instructor know if you have difficulty in attending sessions
- ✓ Ensure you have all the equipment you need with you
- ✓ If you have any problems with the behaviour of fellow club members, report them to the Club Welfare Officer if you are a junior member otherwise report them to the Club Chairperson.
- ✓ If you need to leave the water for any reason during a training session, inform your buddy and your instructor before you do so.
